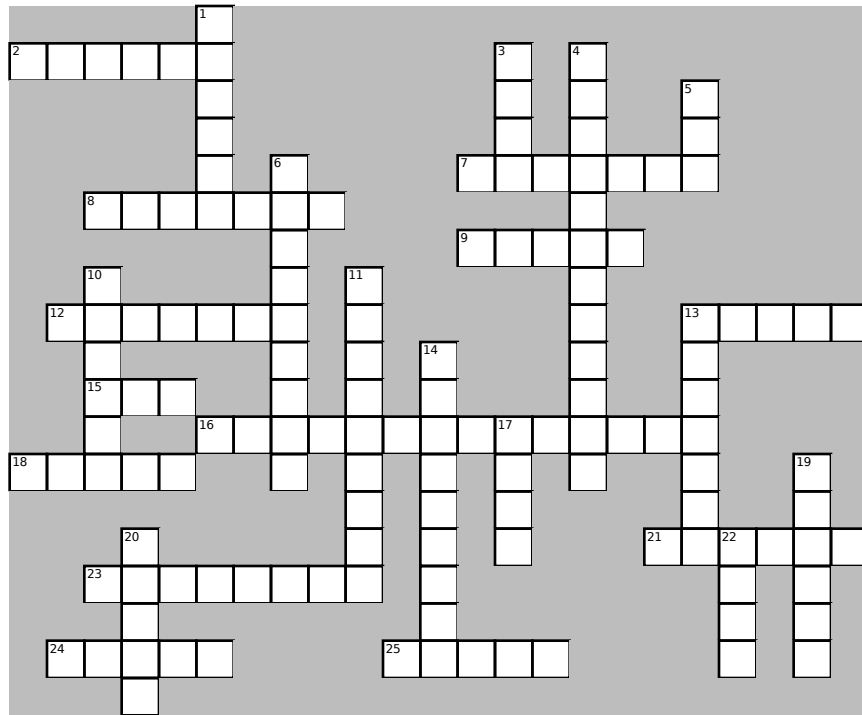


# The Nativity
