



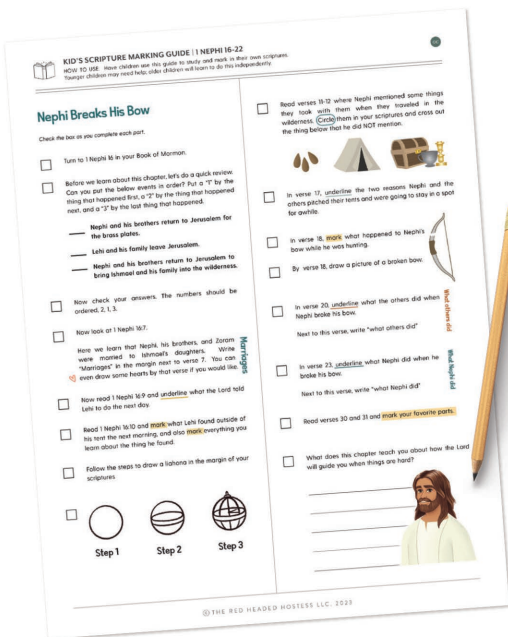

Kid's Marking Guide | 1 Nephi 16-20

IDEAS FOR USE

1. Start by assisting your children and over time, you can step back more and more as they learn to study and navigate the scriptures independently.
2. Set up an inviting atmosphere. Set out the marking guide, their scriptures, a snack, and play music.
3. Same as above, but hide it somewhere in the house so they have to find it.
4. Consider having a set time each week they fill out this guide – like before or after Church.
5. After your child has studied, invite them to give a family lesson about what they learned.
6. Look over the marking guide or ideas for discussions throughout the week. Because your child has previously studied the chapter, they are more prepared and can build upon what they have learned.
7. Use in a classroom setting. The guide can serve as an outline for the lesson and the children can be following along and marking their scriptures.

Now look at 1 Nephi 16:7.

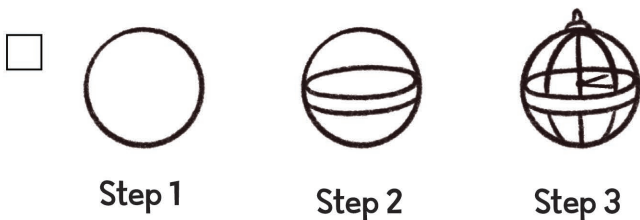
